Title: God Gives Jericho to Israel

Passage: Joshua 6

Principle: Believers should be encouraged to obey God because He always does what He says

Praise: "Great Is the Lord"

Prompt: Ask your child these questions:

- What happened when the people of Israel shouted?
- Why did God bring down the walls of Jericho in this way?

Practice: Help your child apply these truths in the following ways:

- By remembering that difficult situations are opportunities for God to glorify Himself
- By repenting and fleeing to Christ from God's judgment

This week: As a family, read selected portions of Joshua 6

Next week: Joshua 7

Memory verses: "Behold, **I am the Lord**, the God of all flesh; **is anything too difficult for Me?**" **Jeremiah 32:27***

Being Careful How We Build Becoming a Godly Leader The Servant God Uses to Build His City Nehemiah 1

4 characteristics of the servant God uses to make a lasting difference in God's redemptive plans

I. One Who is _____ About More Than the Kingdom of Self

A. Immersed in God's Word—not his own plans

Nehemiah 1:8-9

Leviticus 26:38-45

B. Able to engage with what God is doing—not with his own interests

Nehemiah 1:5

Leviticus 26:42

POINT: If there is no Israel and no pure Israel, then there is no blessing and no redemption for the nations and God is shown to be a liar in His promises!

Nehemiah is most concerned with the redemptive plan of God, in being used of God to help Israel be pure religiously, and remain a sovereign nation for the fulfillment of God's redemptive plan for the nations!

C. Able to mourn over what God mourns—not his own kingdom

Nehemiah 1:4

Matthew 5:4 - *Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted.*

As a foreigner, in order for him to be around the king and queen of Persia like he was, he had most likely been castrated so that his seed would not be intermixed with or be a threat to the king’s dynasty or harem. We know of no children or wife of Nehemiah and the Greek translation of the Old Testament calls Nehemiah a “eunuch.”
