



### Being Careful How We Build Becoming a Godly Leader Wise Building Nehemiah 2:11-20

2 foundational principles to learn from Nehemiah to be effective disciples in our time		
I. Wise Disciples		
A. Consider carefully the you surround yourself with because they impact the effectiveness of your work		
v.12a - And I arose in the night, I and a few men with me.		
Exodus 34:14-16		
<b>Nehemiah 10:30</b> - We promise not to give our daughters in marriage to the peoples around us or take their daughters for our sons.		
<b>Nehemiah 13:23</b> - In those days I also saw that the Jews had married women from Ashdod, Ammon and Moab.		
B. Understand that some situations require actions to be effective workers		
<b>v.12b</b> - I had not told anyone what my God had put in my heart to do for Jerusalem. There were no mounts with me except the one I was riding on.		
<b>v.16</b> - The officials did not know where I had gone or what I had done; nor had I as yet told the Jews, the priests, the nobles, the officials or the rest who did the work.

**v.13** - So I went out at night by the Valley Gate in the direction of the Dragon's Well and on to the Refuse Gate, inspecting the walls of Jerusalem which were broken down and its gates which were consumed by fire.

**v.17** - Then I said to them, "You see the bad situation we are in, that Jerusalem is desolate and its gates burned by fire. Come, let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem so that we will no longer be a reproach."

**1:11** - Your servants who delight to revere Your name, and make Your servant successful today and grant him compassion before this man. Now I was the cupbearer to the king.

**2:8** - And the king granted them to me because the good hand of my God was on me.

**1 Corinthians 10:13** - No temptation has overtaken you but such as is common to man; and God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will provide the way of escape also, so that you will be able to endure it.
