

## Children's Ministry

#### **READ:** Exodus 7-13 **ASK YOUR CHILD:**

- How did God redeem His people from bondage in Egypt? He sent 10 plagues
- Why were the plagues necessary? Pharaoh would not let the Israelites go.
- What is Passover? A feast celebrating God's mercy when the angel of the Lord "passed over" the Israelites' homes while bringing judgment on the Egyptians
- What is mercy? God withholds the punishment that one deserves

**EMPHASIZE THIS PRINCIPLE:** God redeems His people from bondage. Therefore, we should surrender our lives to Him.

#### **PRACTICE:**

- Praise God for His redeeming people from bondage
- Trust God by quickly obeying and repenting
