

Growing What God Has Given Growth Essentials Growing by Changing Our Desires James 4:1-10

The church was facing diverse trials

James 1:2 - Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials...

These trials included problems in their personal relationships

James 1:19 - This you know, my beloved brethren. But everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger...

James 1:26 - If anyone thinks himself to be religious, and yet does not bridle his tongue but deceives his own heart, this man's religion is worthless.

James 2:1 - My brethren, do not hold your faith in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ with an attitude of personal favoritism.

James 3:6 - And the tongue is a fire, the very world of iniquity; the tongue is set among our members as that which defiles the entire body, and sets on fire the course of our life, and is set on fire by hell.

James 4:11 - Do not speak against one another, brethren.

James 5:9 - Do not complain, brethren, against one another...

John 17: 22-23 - The glory which You have given Me I have given to them, that they may be one, just as We are one; I in them and You in Me, that they may be perfected in unity, so that the world may know that You sent Me, and loved them, even as You have loved Me.

I.	. Realize the Cause of Conflict—My, "My Life for Me" (4:1-3)
	A. "Quarrels and conflicts" = hostility in relationships. This term can include hostile relationships between nations (i.e. "war" as in KJV), v. 1.
	B. Hostilities in relationships that can in the extreme lead to "murder" v. 2
	C. The hostilities come from your "pleasures" (v. 1, 3), "lust/envy" (v. 2)

D. We learn from other places of Scripture (Matt 6:21; 15:15–20) those "pleasures in your members" are the motivations of your heart which drive your behavior.

Matthew 6:21 - ...for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

II. Be _______ by the Description of Living for My Pleasurers—"Spiritual Adultery & Pride" (James 4:4-6)

A. Spiritual "Adultery" (v. 4–5)

James 4:4-5 - You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. Or do you think that the Scripture speaks to no purpose: "He jealously desires the Spirit which He has made to dwell in us"?

B. "Proud" (v. 6)

"God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

You have conflict with neighbors because you have conflict with God in your pride and as "spiritual adulterers."

For the one principle of hell is—I am my own. I am my own king and my own subject. I am the centre from which go out my thoughts; I am the object and end of my thoughts; back upon me as the alpha and omega of life, my thoughts return.

My own glory is, and ought to be, my chief care; my ambition, to gather the regards of men to the one centre, myself.

My pleasure is my pleasure.

My kingdom is—as many as I can bring to acknowledge my greatness over them.

My judgment is the faultless rule of things.

My right is—what I desire.

The more I am all in all to myself, the greater I am.

The less I acknowledge debt or obligation to another; the more I close my eyes to the fact that I did not make myself; the more self-sufficing I feel or imagine myself—the greater I am.

I will be free with the freedom that consists in doing whatever I am inclined to do, from whatever quarter may come the inclination. To do my own will so long as I feel anything to be my will, is to be free, is to live. George McDonald (Unspoken Sermons; http://www.online-literature.com/george-macdonald/unspoken-sermons/30/)

III. ______ by Embracing the Cure for Conflict—A New Pleasure—"My life for you", "I Am Not My Own" (James 4:7–10)

A. Submitting to God (v. 7)—In submission to God we abandoned the principle of "my life for me"—living for my own hedonistic pleasures

B. Resisting the Devil (v. 7)—The devil is the epitome of "my life for me" and "I am my own." (cf. James 3:14-15)

James 3:14-15 - But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and so lie against the truth. This wisdom is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly, natural, demonic.

- C. Drawing near to God (v. 8)—learn the "choreography of Heaven" in the Gospel, "my life for you."
- D. Repenting (vv. 8-9)

James 4:8-9 - ...Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. Be miserable and mourn and weep; let your laughter be turned into mourning and your joy to gloom.

"My life for yours: it may mean three seconds of my time to redeem some thoughtless bit of self-indulgence on the part of someone else, or it may mean, or did mean, Golgotha, where My Life for Yours was supremely dramatized and entails our eternal joy." George McDonald, The Night Far Spent, 129
