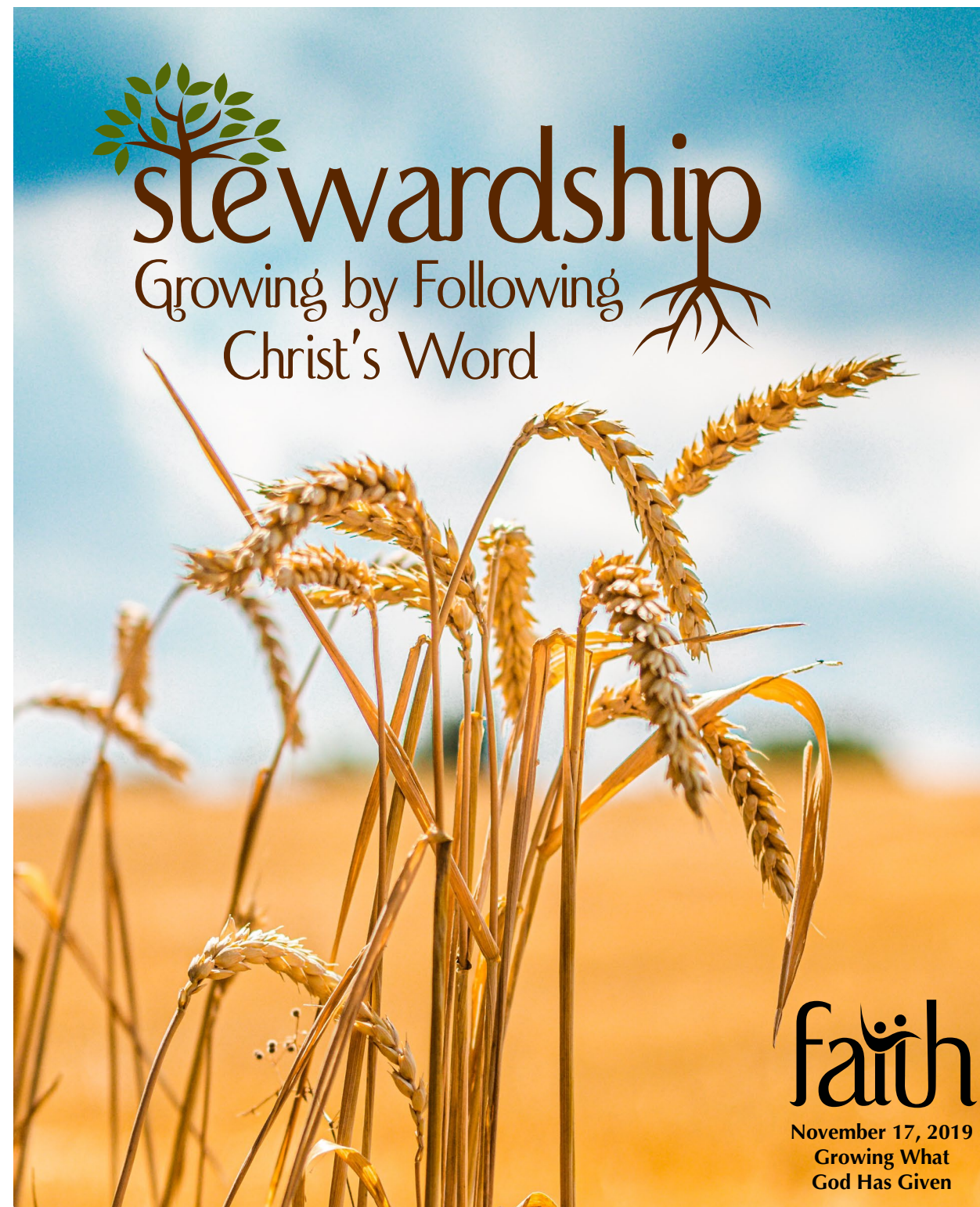

# Children's Ministry

**READ:** Exodus 25-31, 40

**ASK YOUR CHILD:**

- What purpose did the tabernacle serve? *Israel worshipped God who dwelled among His people there.*
- Why did God tell the Israelites to build the tabernacle? *God wanted close fellowship with His people.*
- Why were sacrifices offered? *Sacrifices served as payment for sin.*

**EMPHASIZE THIS PRINCIPLE:** God dwells with His people. Therefore, we should repent and obey Him.

**PRACTICE:**

- Repent from sin and turn to Christ.
- Rejoice that faith in Jesus allows God to dwell in us.

**PREPARE FOR NEXT WEEK:** Read Leviticus 1-7

## Growing What God Has Given Stewardship of Your Treasures

**Matthew 6:16-24**

### 4 Key Principles of Stewardship

God owns everything, you own nothing.

God entrusts you with everything you have.

You can either increase or diminish what God has given you—He wants you to increase it.

God can call you into account at any time—it may be today.

4 questions we must ask ourselves concerning the stewardship of our treasures

A treasure is anything that you value

### I. Who Is My \_\_\_\_\_

**Matthew 6:16-18** - *Whenever you fast, do not put on a gloomy face as the hypocrites do, for they neglect their appearance so that they will be noticed by men when they are fasting. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full. But you, when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face so that your fasting will not be noticed by men, but by your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees what is done in secret will reward you.*

**Psalms 139:7-12** - *Where can I go from Your Spirit? Or where can I flee from Your presence? If I ascend to heaven, You are there; if I make my bed in Sheol, behold, You are there. If I take the wings of the dawn, if I dwell in the remotest part of the sea, even there Your hand will lead me, and Your right hand will lay hold of me. If I say, "Surely the darkness will overwhelm me, and the light around me will be night," even the darkness is not dark to You, and the night is as bright as the day. Darkness and light are alike to You...*



II. Where Is My \_\_\_\_\_

**Matthew 6:19-21** - *Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys, and where thieves do not break in or steal; for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.*

“Spiritual treasure should be defined as broadly as possible—as everything that believers can take with them beyond the grave—e.g., holiness of character, obedience to all of God’s commandments, souls won for Christ, and disciples nurtured in the faith. In this context, however, storing up treasures focuses particularly on the compassionate use of material resources to meet others’ physical and spiritual needs, in keeping with the priorities of God’s kingdom (vv. 25–34; cf. Luke 16:8–13).” Craig Blomberg, *Matthew* (vol. 22; The NAC), pg. 123

IV. Who Is My \_\_\_\_\_

**Matthew 6:24** - *No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth.*

**Matthew 11:28-30** - *Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.*
