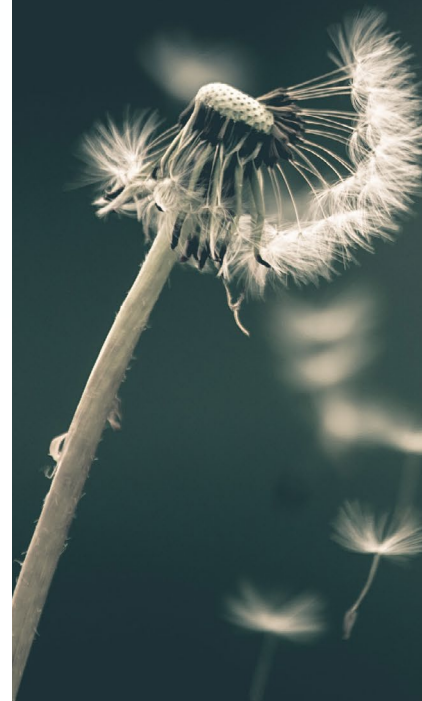

Children's Ministry

READ: Judges 1-3

ASK YOUR CHILD:

- What cycle was repeated throughout the book of Judges? *Israel rebelled against God; God judged Israel through its enemies; Israel cried out for relief; God provided deliverance through the judges.*
- What was a judge, and what was his or her job in Israel? *Judges were leaders who strengthened and delivered Israel from peril.*

EMPHASIZE THIS PRINCIPLE: God expects our full devotion. Therefore, we should obey Him.

PRACTICE:

- Identify and forsake any desire that is stronger than your desire to please God.
- Thank God for showing mercy to sinners.

Living for the Progress of the Gospel

Philippians 1:12-30

3 superior ways to live for the progress of the Gospel

I. Proclaim the _____ Regardless of Your Circumstances

A. Know through _____ the gospel is advanced

Philippians 1:12-14 - *Now I want you to know, brethren, that my circumstances have turned out for the greater progress of the gospel, so that my imprisonment in the cause of Christ has become well known throughout the whole praetorian guard and to everyone else, and that most of the brethren, trusting in the Lord because of my imprisonment, have far more courage to speak the word of God without fear.*

Romans 8:28 - *And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.*

1. God uses your suffering to advance the gospel because your suffering allows others to know your cause

2. God uses your suffering to enable others to boldly advance the Gospel

Philippians 1:14 - *...and that most of the brethren, trusting in the Lord because of my imprisonment, have far more courage to speak the word of God without fear.*

B. Rejoice because the Gospel is _____ in the good and bad

Philippians 1:15-18 - *Some, to be sure, are preaching Christ even from envy and strife, but some also from good will; the latter do it out of love, knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the gospel; the former proclaim Christ out of selfish ambition rather than from pure motives, thinking to cause me distress in my imprisonment. What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed; and in this I rejoice.*

God is more powerful than our motives

II. Live for _____ All Your Days

- A. Experience the _____ of your deliverance
- B. Exalt Christ by having joy in your _____

Philippians 1:20-23 - *...according to my earnest expectation and hope, that I will not be put to shame in anything, but that with all boldness, Christ will even now, as always, be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death. For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain. But if I am to live on in the flesh, this will mean fruitful labor for me; and I do not know which to choose. But I am hard-pressed from both directions, having the desire to depart and be with Christ, for that is very much better...*

2 Corinthians 5:6-9 - *Therefore, being always of good courage, and knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord— for we walk by faith, not by sight— we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord. Therefore we also have as our ambition, whether at home or absent, to be pleasing to Him.*

- C. See the joy your _____ brings to others

III. Conduct Yourself in a Manner _____ of the Gospel

- A. Stand firm in _____ with other believers

Philippians 1:27-28 - *Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I will hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel; in no way alarmed by your opponents—which is a sign of destruction for them, but of salvation for you, and that too, from God.*

- B. To receive God's _____ of suffering for Christ

Philippians 1:29-30 - *For to you it has been granted for Christ's sake, not only to believe in Him, but also to suffer for His sake, experiencing the same conflict which you saw in me, and now hear to be in me.*
