ISRAEL DISOBEYS GOD READ: JUDGES 1-3

Ask Your Child:

- What cycle was repeated throughout the book of Judges? Israel rebelled against God; God judged Israel through it's enemies; Israel cried out for relief; God provided deliverance through the judges.
- What was a judge, and what was his or her job in Israel? Judges were leaders who strengthened and delivered Israel from peril.

EMPHASIZE THIS PRINCIPLE: God expects our full devotion. Therefore, we should obey Him.

PRACTICE:


- •Identify and forsake any desire that is stronger than your desire to please God.

John 20:30-31 - Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name.
