HOLDING TO A BETTER HOPE OF THE FUTURE**

Hebrews 6:9-20

2 reasons we can have full assurance of hope to the end

I. We _____ a Just God (vv.9-10)

Hebrews 6:9-10 - *But, beloved, we are convinced of better things concerning you, and things that accompany salvation, though we are speaking in this way. For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints.*

A. He _____ us to help us persevere (cf. 6:4-8)

B. He _____ and rewards our work and love for him
(v.10)

Hebrews 6:10 - *For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints.*

**II. _____ That Our God Desires You to be Overflowing with
Rock Solid Hope (vv.11-20)**

A. God has given many examples to _____ to help us
persevere on to inherit his promises (vv.11-12)

Hebrews 6:11-12 - *And we desire that each one of you show the same diligence so as to realize the full assurance of hope until the end, so that you will not be sluggish, but imitators of those who through faith and patience inherit the promises.*

1. The example of Abraham (vv.13-15)

Hebrews 6:13-15 - *For when God made the promise to Abraham, since He could swear by no one greater, He swore by Himself, saying, "I WILL SURELY BLESS YOU AND I WILL SURELY MULTIPLY YOU." And so, having patiently waited, he obtained the promise.*

B. God has gone over and above with two unchangeable things to
_____ the promise (vv.13-18)

Hebrews 6:16-18 - *For men swear by one greater than themselves, and with them an oath given as confirmation is an end of every dispute. In the same way God, desiring even more to show to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of His purpose, interposed with an oath, so that by two unchangeable things in which it is impossible for God to lie, we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us.*

1. God makes promises

2. God makes an oath

3. God cannot lie

C. God has given us an _____ of hope for our soul (vv.18c-20)

Hebrews 6:18c-19 - *...we who have taken refuge would have strong encouragement to take hold of the hope set before us. This hope we have as an anchor of the soul, a hope both sure and steadfast and one which enters within the veil...*

1. Jesus the forerunner and eternal high priest

Hebrews 6:20 - *...where Jesus has entered as a forerunner for us, having become a high priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek.*
