I. _____ the Ministry

Galatians 6:6 - *The one who is taught the word is to share all good things with the one who teaches him.*

Galatians 6:9-10 - *Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary. So then, while we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith.*

2 Corinthians 4:1, 16-18 - *Therefore, since we have this ministry, as we received mercy, we do not lose heart...Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day. For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison, while we look not at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen; for the things which are seen are temporal, but the things which are not seen are eternal.*
