CALEB'S KIN (SENIORS 55+)

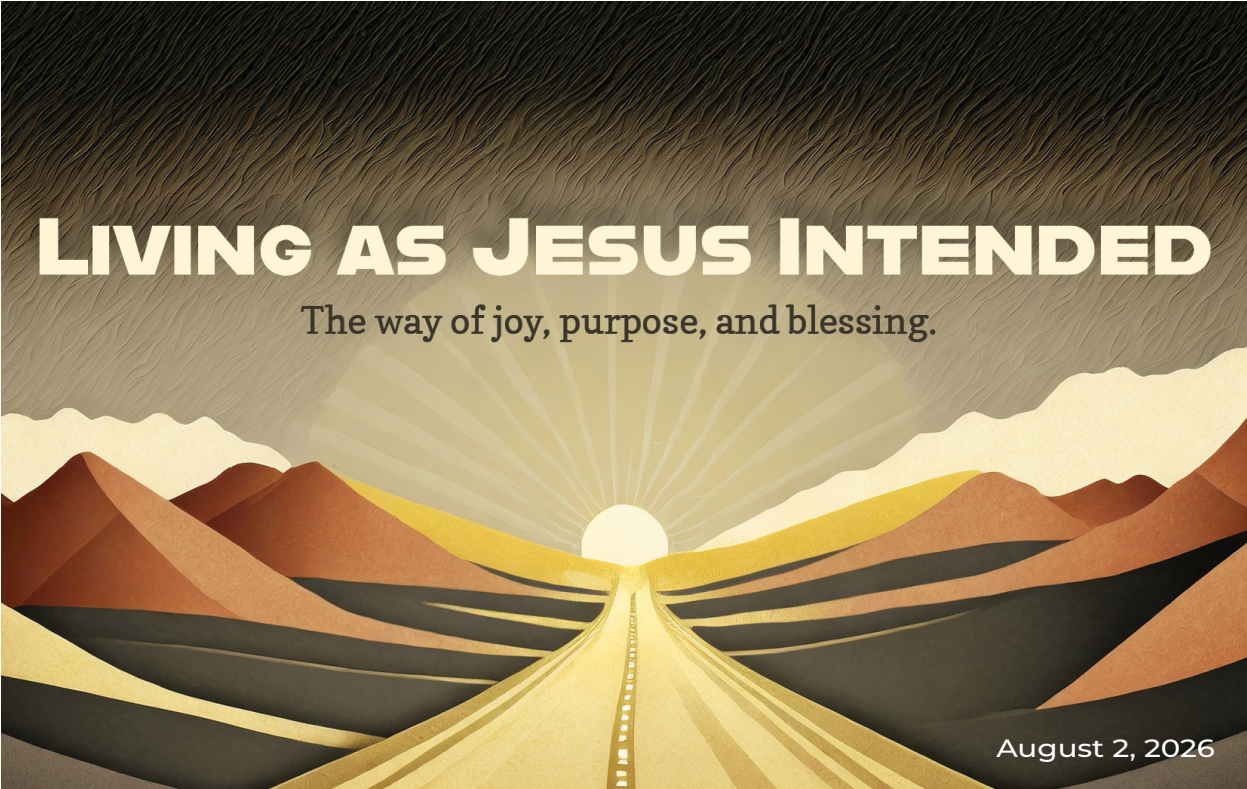
