# SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON: JULY 16

Title: God Chooses Jacob over Esau

Passage: Genesis 25:21–26; 27:1–29

**Principle:** God sovereignly chooses whomever He wants to accomplish His purposes.

Praise: "God Will Take Care of You"

**Prompt:** Ask your child these questions:

- What were the names of the twins born to Isaac and Rebekah?
- Which brother did God choose to receive the birthright?
- How did Jacob steal the inheritance?
- How was God gracious to Jacob?

**Practice:** Help your child apply these truths in the following ways:

- By patiently waiting for God's timing.
- By not committing one sin to make up for another


