GOD SHOWS MERCY TO JONAH AND NINEVEH

READ: Ionah 1-4

#### Ask Your Child:

- Why didn't Jonah want to preach to Nineveh? Jonah didn't want God to show the Ninevites mercy.
- How was God merciful to Jonah and Nineveh? God gave both the opportunity to repent.

EMPHASIZE THIS PRINCIPLE: God is merciful. Therefore, we should repent and share His mercy with others.

#### PRACTICE:

- Thank God for being merciful to sinners.
- Ask God to use you to show mercy to others.

## Hope in Everyday Suffering Manifestations of Hope in Suffering 1 Peter 2:18-25

- **1 Peter 2:9** But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for God's own possession, <u>so that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him.</u>
- **1 Peter 2:12** Keep your behavior excellent among the Gentiles, so that in the thing in which they slander you as evildoers, they may because of your good deeds, <u>as they observe them, glorify God in the day of visitation</u>.
- **1 Peter 1:7** ...so that the proof of your faith, being more <u>precious</u> than gold...
- **1 Peter 2:4** And coming to Him as to a living stone which has been rejected by men, but is choice and <u>precious</u> in the sight of God...
- **1 Peter 2:6** For this is contained in Scripture: "Behold, I lay in Zion a choice stone, a <u>precious</u> corner stone, and he who believes in Him will not be disappointed."
- 1 Peter 2:7 This precious value, then, is for you who believe.
- **1 Peter 3:4** ...but let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the imperishable quality of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is <u>precious</u> in the sight of God.

3 specific actions to take during unjust suffering that God finds precious

I.	a Submissive Posture (vv. 18-20)
	A. By ourselves under appropriate authorities: "Submit" – place yourself willingly under (v. 18)
	B. By authorities appropriate respect
	1 Peter 2:17 - Honor all people, love the brotherhood, fear God, honor the king.
	1 Peter 2:18 - Servants, be submissive to your masters with all <u>respect</u>
	1 Peter 3:2as they observe your chaste and <u>respectful</u> behavior.
	<b>1 Peter 3:15</b> always being ready to make a defense to everyone who asks you to give an account for the hope that is in you, yet with gentleness and <u>reverence</u> .
	C. By willingly consequences for doing with is right
II.	Your Calling to be like Christ (v. 21-24)
	<b>1 Peter 2:21-24</b> - For you have been called for this purpose, since Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example for you to follow in His steps, who committed no sin, nor was any deceit found in His mouth; and while being reviled, He did not revile in return; while suffering, He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously; and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

	<b>1 Peter 2:19-20, 23-25</b> - For this finds <u>favor</u> But if when you do what is right and suffer for it you patiently endure it, this finds <u>favor</u> with God but kept <u>entrusting</u> Himself to Him who judges righteously, <u>for by His wounds you were healed.</u> For you were continually straying like sheep, <u>but now you have returned</u> to the Shepherd and Guardian of your souls.
