- 1 complete change of clothes in a large, labeled Ziploc bag. Please include pants, shirt, socks, and underwear. This will be kept in your child's cubby all year.

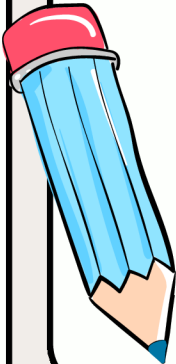
Nap Children:

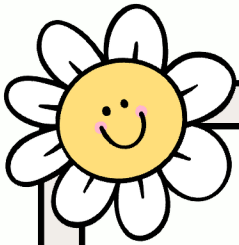
- 1 standard size backpack which contains the following:
