**Three times, we are commanded NOT TO FRET
(37: 1, 7, 8)**

BUT

Submit to God

Don't envy

Cease from anger

When we submit to God, we:

Trust Him

Obey Him

Are patient

Are humble

Delight in the Lord

How do we trust God (37:3a, 5) ?

We cast our anxieties on Him

We give Him the problem

We leave it with Him

(I Peter 5:7)

How do we obey God (37:3b) ?

We just do it – do what He says

(Simple but not easy)

How do we put on patience (37: 7, 9) ?

Trust in God's timing

Believe His promises

**Remember that He will never leave us or
forsake us (Hebrews 13:5)**

How do we put on humility (37: 11) ?

Realize our own weakness and sinfulness

Don't trust in ourselves

How do we put on humility (37: 11) ?

How do we delight in the Lord (37: 4) ?

We trust and obey God

We are patient and are humble

Learn to forgive (Matthew 18)

Respond with good (Romans 12)

Trust God to defend us, to do what is right.
