7. Describe fully all activities of Registrant during the period for or in the interests of each foreign principal named during item 6.

A. In addition to the preparation and dissemination of news releases, writing letters and general public relations counseling, activities for the Government of Israel Investment Authority, and the office of the Israel Trade Commissioner, for the six months ended March 30, 1965 consisted of:

1. Development of articles and special sections in business, financial and international trade publications.
2. Meetings with trade journal editors to develop articles on Israel's industry, or visits to Israel by journalists.
3. Serving as liaison between the Government of Israel Investment Authority and the non-governmental American-Israel Chamber of Commerce & Industry in an effort to broaden trade relations between the two nations.
4. Editing and revision of speeches for delivery by Israel Investment Authority Director and the Economic Minister.
5. Staff member visited Israel and gathered material describing Israel's new industrial look for use in a brochure, trade articles and other outlets.
6. Worked with script writer who is producing film on Israeli industry.
7. Contacted fashion publications to solicit coverage of Israel Fashion Week and focus attention on Israeli fashions.

B. During the past six months, Ruder & Finn has been engaged in the following activities on behalf of the Japanese External Trade Organizations:

1. Japan Today Film Series. Six half hour films on Japan Today were broadcast over television stations WNEW-TV and WNBC-TV, New York
