

4. We have arranged for Mexican Television (Televisa) to interview the Spanish Prime Minister during the month of April in Spain.
5. We have been in contact with various television networks here and in the United Kingdom to provide them with information leading to interviews with members of the Spanish Government.
6. Marvin Frankel and Francisco Moreno made three trips to Madrid during this period for consultation in carrying out the above mentioned activities.
