The Ente Nazionale Italiano per il Turismo (ENIT) is an entity operated wholly by the Administration of the Italian Republic. Its headquarters is in Rome (Italy) and the twenty-seven delegations abroad (three of which are in the United States) act under the provision of the New York Convention of International Tourism signed on 4th June 1954 and ratified by the Italian Government in 1957. The San Francisco de-legation, known as The Italian Government Travel Office, which covers the Western-United States, is composed of Italian civil servants, holding Service Passports with Visa status A2, regularly notified to the Department of State in Washington (Form DS 394), through the Italian Embassy. This ENIT office is not engaged in any commercial or political activity and its sole purpose is promoting travel to Italy, offering services free of charge to tour operators, travel agents, carriers and other travel related associations which cater to Americans travelling abroad. It provides, more-over, information to the public upon request about tourist facilities and other attractions in Italy. For this purpose, during the six month reporting period this office has: participated in the most important travel shows which take place in the West coast; conducted seminars and workshops for representatives of US travel industry; organized familiarization trips to Italy for trade media representatives; co-operated in the organization of exhibitions, events and other functions realized by or under the auspices of the Italian diplomatic or consular representatives in the U.S.A. Furthermore has replied to about 50,000 request for information on tourism in Italy received from prospective American tourists, local travel agent and journalists, interested in this specific subject.

<sup>1</sup>The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual. (See Rule 100(a)(9)).
