1. Government of the Republic of Cameroon
There were no reportable activities performed on behalf of the Government of the Republic of Cameroon during this reporting period.
2. Embassy of the People's Republic of China
During the reporting period, Registrant counseled the foreign principal on U.S. Congressional matters. This included monitoring, compiling information, and analyzing the potential legal and political ramifications of legislation regarding matters of interest to the foreign principal. Such legislation included the House (H.R. 2810) and Senate National Defense Authorization Acts for Fiscal Year 2018 and foreign principal-related provisions and amendments thereto, including U.S. relations with Taiwan and Hong Kong, cybersecurity, and matters pertaining to the Asia-Pacific region more generally. Moreover, Registrant advised the foreign principal on background and developments concerning other subjects, including the FY 2017 and FY 2018 appropriations processes (including H.R. 1301 and committee-level matters), U.S. relations with Taiwan, Hong Kong and North Korea, cybersecurity, matters pertaining to the Asia-Pacific region, South China Sea, currency, immigration, Tibet, human rights, trade, and sanctions legislation (including H.R. 535, H.R. 1644, H.R. 2537, S. 659, S. 1051, S. 1118, and S. 1187). More generally, Registrant monitored and informed the foreign principal of Congressional hearings and other events and developments regarding matters of interest to the foreign principal.
3. Republic of Croatia
