As explained in 8(a) above my representation of Triad was extremely limited, and my answers to the broad questions in 8(b) are necessarily based on a very limited knowledge as to the finances of the company. When I have checked "yes" I am reasonably sure of my facts. When I have checked "no", I don't think any alternative is relevant. When I have checked nothing, I don't have any idea as to the answer.

Regarding "yes" answers: Triad is, I believe owned by Adnan Khashoggi, a Saudi Arabian private citizen, and his brothers. Because they own the company, I assume they direct and control it.

The words "subsidized in whole" do not apply, because Triad is a business concern and I believe a profitable one, although I also assume they have borrowed money from time to time to finance certain ventures.

Informal arrangement calling for monthly fee of \$2,000, subject to cancellation by either party at any time, plus expenses incurred on client's behalf. Relationship existed for two months, from June 7, 1975 to August 7, 1975, at which time it was cancelled by registrant. Principal was billed for \$4,000 in fees and \$421.97 for expenses, which have been fully paid.

The purpose of the representation was to provide information and advice to the client on the subject of Defense Department policy and Congressional hearings with reference to foreign agents fees and commissions in connection with the sale by American companies of military equipment and services to foreign governments. Triad Enterprises represented a number of U.S. companies engaged in such sales. Performance included coverage of hearings, analysis of testimony and informational contacts with the Defense Security Assistance Agency in the Department of Defense.

5. Describe fully the activities the registrant engages in or proposes to engage in on behalf of the above foreign principal.

Activities were solely as described above. Nothing else was involved, and the client relationship has ended.
