The main function of the Govt of India Tourist Office is the promotion of tourist traffic to India. This office launches an advertising campaign through our advertising agency M/s McCann Direct. The advertising is in major consumer magazines as well as newspapers like New York Times, National History, Travel Holiday, Gourmet, Travel Weekly.

Joint Presentations are held by Govt of India Tourist Office and Air India where local tour operators and travel agents are invited and apprised of the latest tourist facilities available in India. Free literature like travel brochures, posters etc are distributed.

We also participate in various travel trade shows like Henry Davis Shows, Travel Age Show, Travel Market Place, National Sr Travel Planners, Golf Travel Expo etc. List of various shows we participated in during the said period is attached.

Under our hospitality programme this office sends travel writers, editors television teams, photographers etc to India on familiarisation tours and they are treated as guests of the Department of Tourism, Govt of India.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual. 




