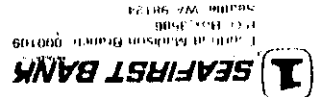

Dear Employer:

I am pleased to enclose your share of a \$200 million dividend from the Washington workers' compensation system, better known as the State Fund. You are one of 130,000 employers sharing in this refund.

The dividend comes from the Accident Fund, the largest of several pools that make up the overall State Fund. Only employers pay into the Accident Fund, which pays benefits for injured workers, such as time-loss and disability awards.

This is the second time in two years that we have returned \$200 million to employers. Continued excellent returns on State Fund investments and lower-than-expected claims costs are the primary reasons for the refund. Your check is for fiscal year 1999 — July 1, 1998 through June 30, 1999. It represents 30.8 percent of the Accident Fund portion of the premium you paid during that period.

The progress that has been made in workplace safety has played no small part in our ability to return this money to you. I greatly appreciate the efforts of employers who are committed to this goal, as well as the hard work of Labor and Industries Director Gary Moore and his staff in managing the State Fund and this project.

The Internal Revenue Service has advised the state that dividends are taxable income and should be included on your federal tax return. I encourage you to discuss this with your tax consultant.
