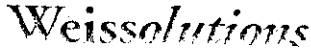

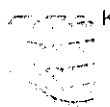

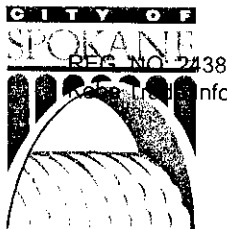

(1) 当方より神戸市医療産業都市構想の説明

(橋本) 6月末にサンフランシスコで経済産業省とジェトロ共催の対日投資セミナーが開催されたが、ジェトロが用意した資料の大半はバイオ関係のものであった。私は西川副大臣を囲む少人数の夕食会にも出席したが、その席でも神戸市の医療産業都市構想は話題に上っていた。私もジェトロの資料に取り上げられている神戸市の構想を読んで驚いている。

(橋本) 神戸なら可能ではないか。JBCとしてもこの集まりの中からそのような動きが出てくるのは歓迎である。私も機会を見て神戸を視察してみたい。シアトルから少し時間はかかるが、是非引き続きJBCのミーティングに参加して欲しい。

5 今後の進め方

6月27日のJBCのミーティングにパネラーで出席していたダイナコムの中野社長、Pixeraの井手社長が神戸の医療産業都市構想に興味を示してくれている。私がお会いして説明するまでは2人とも神戸で医療産業都市構想が進んでいるのはご存知ではなかった。

シアトル事務所として、バイオ産業の集積地の1つであるシリコンバレーにあるJBCとは密に連絡をとって、いろいろな機会に神戸市をPRし、神戸に関心を示してくれる研究者、企業を1人でも増やしていきたいと考えている。
