



1. Gave informal talk at International Club in Washington, D.C., on representing a foreign client.
2. Was interviewed on National Public Radio at its request. No prepared script or other documentation.
3. Helped arrange for the appearance of the Saudi Minister of Petroleum on the CBS "Face the Nation" program, but that appearance was later canceled by CBS before the program was taped.
4. Assisted, at the request of representatives of the Council on Foreign Relations in New York City, for the appearance of two Saudi officials there. Was contacted by other groups for the same purpose but referred those to the Embassy.
5. Helped CBS and NBC production crews, at their request, to prepare for trips to Saudi Arabia to do documentaries there, including visas, meeting Saudi officials and general background. Was not involved in the actual execution of those projects.
