Item 8 of Supplement Report for December 12, 1984 to June 12, 1985

Registrable activities for Saudi Basic Industries Corporation (SABIC) - arranging contacts with indicated U.S. officials - were completed with the close of the meetings referred to and thus as of April 1985; registrable activities for SABIC were the meetings with Congressman Gibbons, Secretary Baldrige and Deputy U.S. Trade Representative Smith.

Item 11

The press meeting referred to, was held for the purpose of providing a briefing by Saudi Embassy officials on details of the visit of King Fahd of Saudi Arabia to Washington to meet with President Reagan, Secretary of State Shultz, Secretary of Defense Weinberger and other U.S. officials. The meeting was arranged primarily by Saudi Embassy and conducted entirely by Saudi officials; but Registrant was of incidental assistance and was present.

I was asked by an outsider on a casual, passing basis to arrange for a meeting for Mr. Findley with the Saudi Arabian Ambassador and did so, but did not attend nor inquire as to the discussion there. The actual arranging of the meeting was handled directly by Embassy personnel.
