Registrant undertook in paragraph 11 to cover information also responsive to 12, as indicated in earlier filing, but seeks below to be responsive to and in 12 per request:

Military sales: evaluated Congressional, Executive Branch, international and U.S. public developments in discussions with Saudi officials. Accompanied them in meetings with Lockheed, LTV and Bell Company defense industry officials, employees and others where Middle East developments and reasons for Saudi Arabia making foreign rather than U.S. arms purchases were discussed, along with presentation by U.S. company officials of U.S. product purchase possibilities. Registrant accompanied Saudi officials and observed rather than being a primary participant and discussant. Did not help arrange meetings.

Trade Legislation: Appraised for Saudi officials U.S. legislative, executive branch and public developments that could affect pending trade legislation on oil, petrochemical and related matters, particularly increased charges and potential restraints on U.S. import of those. Here, too, registrant is essentially interfacing with Saudi officials.

Sat in on meetings of Saudi Ambassador with members of the press, including Washington Post, Wall Street Journal, Atlanta Constitution and New Orleans Time-Picanyne but did not arrange meetings except for Don Oberdorfer of the Washington Post. Was observer, not primary participant in these sessions.
