Met frequently with Embassy personnel to consider U.S., Saudi and other international developments and policy, including pending legislation, administrative regulations, judicial action, public statements and other matters. (Much lighter in this reporting period.)

Traveled to Saudi Arabia, Great Britain, France, Spain, Morocco, New York and California in connection with work of Embassy and to Saudi Arabia, New York, Georgetown, South Carolina, and London for Saudi Basic Industries Corp.

Unusually heavy workload in Saudi Arabia in this reporting period for both principles - six times.

Saudi Basic Industries Corp.

Contract drafting and negotiations with U.S. companies and Saudi personnel for construction and operation of at least five major petrochemical complexes and other industrialization endeavors in Saudi Arabia. American firms include Shell, Fluor, Texas Eastern, Celanese Corp., Dow Chemical, Exxon, Aramco, Mitsubishi, and others. Also Korf Steel on iron-processing project. Emphasis in this reporting period was on the petrochemical projects (especially Shell), contract law, taxation questions, possible conflicts of law problems, anti-trust research and other relevant issues.
