Largest amount of time was spent on U.S. military sale to Saudi Arabia, with the heavy bulk of time counselling Saudi officials. Met with one U.S. Senator at his request, as well as Executive Branch officials. Also a Congressman after legislative review of sale had concluded. Answered a number of media and other inquiries, and had informal dinner at home for a Saudi official with a dozen members from the media. Prepared and distributed printed material entitled "Why Saudi Arabia Needs AWACS," with detailed filing with the Justice Department at the time of distribution.

Met frequently with Embassy personnel and other Saudi officials to consider U.S., Saudi and other developments and policy, including pending court proceedings, executive and administrative actions, public statements, political process, public statements and other matters. Counseled on statements of officials of Embassy. Traveled to Saudi Arabia, France, and New York.

¹The term "foreign principal" includes, in addition to those defined in section 1(b) of the Act, an individual or organization any of whose activities are directly or indirectly supervised, directed, controlled, financed, or subsidized in whole or in major part by a foreign government, foreign political party, foreign organization or foreign individual. (See Rule 100(a)(9)).




