



FURTHER DETAIL RESPONSIVE TO PARAGRAPH 11 OF FILING -

- July 9-12 Flew to San Francisco and attended formal opening of the University of California Berkeley's Saudi-funded new quarters for the Middle East Center there, along with Saudi officials. The HRH Prince Sultan bin Abdulaziz Foundation in Saudi Arabia had given five million dollars to the Center for new quarters as well as professorial and student exchanges with Middle East universities, conferences, seminars and other educational purposes.
- July 30-Aug. 4 Attended the Republican National Convention with Saudi officials, for them to observe A U.S. national political gathering. Included attending sessions of the convention in Philadelphia.
- Aug. 9-10 Attended meetings in Seattle, Washington, with officials of the Boeing Company, along with Saudi officials.
- Aug. 11-19 Attended the Democratic National Convention in Los Angeles with Saudi officials, with them observing the other major U.S. political party's gathering. Included attending session of the Convention.
- Aug. 18-23 Attended the 50th Anniversary of the Aspen Institute in Aspen, Colorado, with Saudi officials. Registrant had helped in organizing an international gathering under the sponsorship of the Institute on the effects of globalization and other developments on world poverty. A number of U.S. officials, journalists, private-sector leaders and others attended the Institute's 50th Anniversary and conference on world poverty; and Registrant met with a number of them.
- Sept. 7 Attended book party in Washington D.C. honoring the publication of Robert F. Kennedy biography by Newsweek editor Evan Thomas. There were a number of other individuals from the media there along with past and present U.S. government officials.
- Sept. 2 Attended private party at home of journalist Roger Mudd along with a number of other media figures, present and former members of the U.S. government. Saudi Arabia was mentioned only briefly in passing.
- Sept. 25 Attended Saudi National Day reception at the Saudi Embassy in Wash. D.C. It included a number of U.S. officials, business leaders and journalists.
- October 13 Attended dinner given by the Aspen Institute in Wash. D.C. for a number of members of the U.S. government, media and private sector. Saudi Arabia was mentioned only briefly.
- Oct. 20 Attended Middle East Institute annual dinner in Wash. D.C. It included a number of U.S. government officials, journalists and others.

- Oct. 30 Attended private party at the Cosmos Club in Wash. D.C. with a number of members of the media, U.S. government and others. Saudi Arabia was mentioned only in passing.
- Nov. 22 Attended reception at the Lebanese Embassy in Washington D.C. with members of the dioplomatic corp, business community and media. Saudi Arabia mentioned only in passing.

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
