III - ACTIVITIES

Question 11

During the reporting period, governmental contacts included the following:

White House (Congressional liaison)

Registrant talked primarily with Mrs. Pam Turner and members of her staff. There were discussions of the Saudi Pavilion at the World's Fair in Knoxville and the President's remarks during his visit to the World's Fair. There was a brief review of the AWACS vote of October 1981 as well as a brief discussion of the series in the New Republic magazine.

U.S. Treasury (Saudi Affairs)

Principal contacts were with Phil Hinson of that staff with regard to the activities of the U.S.-Saudi Joint Economic Commission, primarily with respect to agenda items for the commission's annual meeting. Principal purpose of contact was to stay abreast of the activity of the JEC. On one occasion, on April 12, 1982, Mr. Hinson was Registrant's guest for a meal at the Capital Hilton.

State Department (Public Affairs Office)

Primary contact was with Tom Homan, NEA Desk. Subjects covered included the production of the State Department Background Notes on Saudi Arabia; the Saudi Pavilion at the World's Fair; U.S. press coverage of the Middle East in general and Saudi Arabia in particular. Permission was also sought to attend press briefings. In addition, Registrant undertook to inform Mr. Homan of Arab-American activities and sought his impressions of the Arab-American community and its relationship to the State Department.
