Dear Mr. Parellada:

This letter is to set forth the terms of an agreement between this law firm and your association. The law firm of Mudge Rose Guthrie Alexander & Ferdon hereby undertakes to represent the interests of Camara de la Industria Aceitera de la Republica Argentina (CIARA) in the agency proceeding involving the Section 301 petition filed by the National Soybean Processors Association with respect to exports of soybeans and products thereof from Argentina.

Our activities will include the development of a legal strategy for the proceeding and the presentation of facts and arguments which rebut the allegations of the petition and set forth substantive positions on your behalf. Our representation will necessarily involve discussing relevant issues and making oral arguments before the parties to the investigation, including the United States Government agencies which participate in 301 proceedings under the chairmanship of the United States Trade Representative. We anticipate that we will also keep your Embassy officials here advised of the procedural aspects and steps taken on your behalf.

Our efforts necessarily will involve intensive effort and travel to Buenos Aires.

The duration of this agreement shall be for one year, during which this firm shall be paid \$160,000, payable in quarterly increments of \$40,000, due on June 16, September 1, and December 1, 1986, and March 1, 1987. In addition, this law firm will be reimbursed for out-of-pocket disbursements which

shall be billed and payable monthly. Such disbursements shall include travel, long distance telephone calls, telex, telefax, purchase of publications, secretarial overtime, foreign postage, reproduction of documents, business meals, and other such expenses, but shall not include office overhead, local telephone calls, and similar routine expenses.

At the conclusion of the proceeding, if the sum which would have been payable on an hourly basis is 20 percent or more above or below the sum actually paid on the quarterly fee basis, both parties would be prepared to reach a mutually acceptable modification of the total compensation.
