Toyota Motor Corporation. Activities conducted during this period have included: following the status of Clean Air Act amendments in both House of Representatives and Senate Committees; following the status of the proposed Automobile Theft Prevention Act in the House of Representatives and Senate; following the status of developments in the corporate average fuel economy (CAFE) standards program; following the status of highway safety and consumer protection related legislation in the House and Senate (includes legislation affecting odometers, seat belt usage, crashworthiness); following the status of DOT and HUD-Independent Agency Appropriations Acts for Fiscal Year 1985; following the status of litigation under the Clean Air Act and National Traffic and Safety Act; following the status of fuel; preparation of oral and written reports to the foreign principal on the status of the above bills and activities; preparation of the semi-annual report under the Foreign Agent Registration Act; preparation of quarterly statements under the Federal Regulation of Lobbying Act; advice on interpretation of existing emissions and safety regulations.
