Supplementary Information to Attachment "B"

During the six-month reporting period ending July 10, 1986, United International Consultants (UIC) was active in opposing S. 2498, H.R. 4868, S. 2570, S. 2636, and the Kennedy-Weicker Amendment to the tax bill, all of which sought to impose sanctions against the Republic of South Africa. Every contact with government officials listed below pertained to our opposition to these measures except where otherwise noted.

- (a) Represented Principal's interests in various business meetings and conferences held in Los Angeles and New York where such topics as economic sanctions and disinvestment were on the agenda.

A UIC representative attended all of the biweekly, Thursday morning meetings of the "Stanton Group", at the Free Congress Foundation, during which foreign policy issues were discussed by representatives of national conservative organizations. These meetings occurred on January 23, February 6 and 20, March 6 and 20, April 3 and 17, May 1, 15 and 29, June 12 and 26, July 10.

UIC also participated in a series of dinner meetings sponsored by Coalitions for America at the Free Congress Foundation during which foreign policy issues were discussed. These dinner meetings were held January 29, April 3, May 1 and 27.

A UIC representative attended a series of regularly-scheduled luncheons attended by Congressional staff at which domestic and foreign policy issues were discussed. These luncheons occurred on February 20, March 4, 10, 11, 12, 18 and 20, April 8, 17, 22 and 29, May 15 and June 10, 19 and 24.

The cost of participating in the above-mentioned meetings was \$1,920.70.
