Holland & Knight LLP respectfully requests a waiver of the requirement, pursuant to Section 2(a)(2) of the Foreign Agents Registration Act, to file the firm's partnership agreement and periodic amendments thereto. The partnership agreement was amended on November 12, 2004, and the filing of the amended agreement is required in response to Item 3 of the firm's Supplemental Statement for the six-month period ending February 7, 2005.


In its initial registration, Holland & Knight LLP filed a copy of the then-extant partnership agreement. The new, amended agreement is substantially similar to the one on file but contains a variety of modifications with respect to issues relating to firm governance, distribution of firm revenues, internal financial procedures, and other similar matters. Nothing in the partnership agreement, either directly or indirectly, concerns the firm's representation of foreign principals.

The waiver is requested because the amended partnership agreement contains, among other provisions, specific information on the compensation paid to each of the firm's capital partners. Disclosure of this information would constitute breach of these individual's privacy and, as noted, neither it or any other information in the partnership agreement has any relevance whatsoever to the purposes for which the FARA was enacted. You are, of course, welcome to review the amended partnership amendment if doing so is necessary for the disposition of this request.

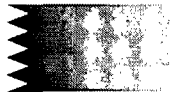
