- * Dissemination of information on behalf of the Nicaraguan Resistance. This office issues press releases on an ad hoc basis, published a newsletter, and provides concerned citizenry with documents illustrating the stance of the Nicaraguan Resistance.
- * Collection of official views, newspaper and other media reports, and signs of public opinion or activity concerning Nicaragua, on behalf of the Nicaraguan Resistance.
- * Private fundraising efforts, on behalf of the Nicaraguan Resistance - USA Office.
- * Coordination of visits by leaders of the Nicaraguan Resistance to persons and groups, including those mentioned above, concerned with the Nicaraguan question.
- * Visits to public officials, including Members of Congress and government agencies, to discuss development of the Nicaraguan question. The office also assists in the coordination of relations between the Nicaraguan Resistance and states other than the United States.
- * Identification and encouragement, and coordination of civic groups committed to the promotion of democracy in Nicaragua.
- * Being available to the national and international press corps in order to give the views, perspectives, and positions of the Nicaraguan Resistance. This activity includes visiting interested groups and associates at their request.
- * Enhancing communications between the Government of the United States and the Nicaraguan Resistance.
