The following text is identical to the statement issued on May 22, 1991 by the Office of the People's Mojahedin of Iran - Paris, and is being released for your information.

IRAN - HAJJ

- SETTING THE STAGE FOR SEDITION AND 'EXPORT OF REVOLUTION' TO SAUDI ARABIA

In the so-called "Hajj Congress," which convened yesterday after Rafsanjani's opening remarks at the site of Khomeini's tomb, the regime's leading figures again set the stage for sedition and "export of revolution" to Saudi Arabia.

Rafsanjani emphasized that during this year's Hajj, "Imam Khomeini's goals should be retained, because Hajj is the most appropriate occasion to bring up the realities of Islam."

Ahmad Khomeini emphasized that Khamenei has "expressed the exact same views as the Imam [Khomeini], and we must all carry out our duty in this regard," thus revealing the mullahs' plans to again create riots and other disturbances in Mecca.

Reyshahri, former Minister of Khomeini's SAVAK who has been appointed by Khamenei as Head of Iranian Pilgrims specifically to organize the plans for seditious acts during the Hajj, told the gathering: "The Imam's spirit will definitely be watching what we do."

For years, Reyshahri has also been in charge of one of the regime's terrorist groups abroad known as the "Organization for the Islamic Revolution of the Arab Peninsula." Reports from within the regime say that under Khamenei's direct supervision, he is organizing thousands of members of the Guards Corps (Pasdaran), especially from the GC's extra-territorial Qods force, posing as Iranian pilgrims during this year's Hajj. Two Guards commanders, Shirazi and Arbabi, are working directly under Reyshahri in this regard.
