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### **Attachment #1**

The Council of Khalistan works to educate the international community, including the U.S. Government that pressure will be brought to bear on the Indian government to:

1. Stop the genocide of the Sikh Nation.
2. Stop the oppression of the Sikh Nation.
3. Resolve the Sikh problem peacefully through negotiations.
4. Remove the India Army from the Golden Temple allowing free religious access to the Temple and the rest of Punjab.
5. Demarcate the boundaries of Khalistan peacefully through negotiations with the Sikhs.
6. Let groups like Amnesty International enter Punjab to assess the extent of oppression and report to the free world, for example:
  - a. The existence of torture centers, namely Mal Mandi in Amritsar and many other places.
  - b. The existence of death squads.
  - c. Investigations of fake "encounters."
  - d. False arrests of Sikh youths by police and their release after large sums of bribery.
  - e. Intimidation and demoralization of the public.
  - f. Extortion of money by the police.
  - g. Man-made flooding of Punjab by opening the gates of the Bhakra dam.
  - h. Diversion of Punjab's waters to other non-riparian states while there is already a shortage of water in Punjab.
  - i. And many other injustices to the Sikh Nation.
7. Comply with the Panthic Committee's October 7, 1987 declaration of independence, helping to establish through peaceful means a sovereign and independent Sikh Nation by the name of Khalistan.
8. Expose the blatantly illegal interference of the Indian regime in U.S. politics through the illegal transfer of funds from the Indian Embassy through individuals like Lalit Gadhia and Yogesh Gandhi to Members of Congress, Congressional candidates, and political parties here in the United States.

Any nominal expenditure on behalf of the Council of Khalistan of postage and telephone is borne by the office of the International Sikh Organization.

There is no budget for the Council of Khalistan. All goods and services of approximate value amounting to no more than \$3000.00 per six month period are provided for by the International Sikh Organization.
