Republic of Cyprus

On behalf of this foreign principal the registrant provided advice and information regarding developments in the Legislative and Executive Branches that affected the interests of the Republic of Cyprus. The early part of the reporting period included the November 8 elections, which resulted in a change of party control in both Houses of Congress. The registrant undertook an outreach program to acquaint new Members of Congress and the new Leadership with the Cyprus problem. The registrant assisted in working to obtain fair treatment for the Republic of Cyprus under various provisions of U.S. foreign assistance legislation.

The registrant worked on matters affecting the interests of the Republic of Cyprus. These included legislation rescinding unobligated balances of previously appropriated funds and legislation to consolidate the foreign affairs agencies and to authorize funding for their activities, including foreign assistance. The registrant also worked to obtain sponsors and co-sponsors for House and Senate resolutions expressing support for Cypriot President Clerides' proposal to demilitarize all of Cyprus.

The specific legislative goals that the registrant worked to achieve for Cyprus during the reporting period have been (1) to eliminate or minimize the impact on Cyprus of the rescissions legislation, (2) to develop Congressional support for continuing the annual allocation of \$15,000,000 in foreign assistance for Cyprus, (3) to include in Committee reports accompanying legislation, language endorsing foreign assistance for Cyprus and a just resolution of the Cyprus problem, and (4) to include key elements of the demilitarization resolution in the Senate foreign assistance bill. The registrant also prepared a draft Op-Ed article on the demilitarization proposal.

The registrant monitored Congressional hearings and business meetings of direct interest to the Republic of Cyprus including the House International Relations Committee, the Senate Foreign Relations Committee and the House and Senate Appropriations Committees. The registrant drafted memoranda to the Embassy of Cyprus on these meetings. The registrant prepared suggested language for inclusion in Committee reports and letters to Members of Congress. The registrant also prepared written briefing materials to inform Members of Congress and their staffs of the issues involved in the Cyprus problem. The registrant also personally briefed Members of Congress and their staffs on the

status of the Cyprus negotiations and on President Clerides' demilitarization proposal. The registrant continued to advocate a just and lasting resolution of the Cyprus problem based on UN Resolutions and worked closely with the Embassy of Cyprus during this period.
