

ATTACHMENT A

Republic of Cyprus

During the six-month period ending March 31, 1997, the registrant provided advice and information regarding developments in the Congress and the Administration that affected or might affect the interests of the Republic of Cyprus. Our activities and services on behalf of Cyprus were as follows:

- Reporting orally and in writing on legislative and Administration actions and/or plans of concern or interest to Cyprus.
- Monitoring and preparing reports on Congressional hearings and business meetings on issues of direct interest to the Republic of Cyprus. The relevant committees whose activities we monitored included the House International Relations Committee, the Senate Foreign Relations Committee and the House and Senate Appropriations Committees.
- Preparing background papers and talking points for Members of Congress and their staffs to use during meetings of the above committees in support of matters of interest to the Republic of Cyprus as well as statements for use during floor debates in the House and Senate on matters involving the interests of Cyprus.
- Analyzing legislation to identify provisions that may affect the interests of Cyprus.
- Drafting suggested language for inclusion in committee reports accompanying legislation.
- Urging Members of Congress, either directly or through their staffs, to co-sponsor or vote for legislation, including House and Senate resolutions, of interest to Cyprus.
- Meeting with Members of Congress and/or their staffs to brief them on issues involving or of interest to Cyprus.
- Arranging meetings for visiting officials of the Government of Cyprus with Members of Congress.
- Advising officials of the Republic of Cyprus on strategies and methods to advance the objectives of Cyprus in Washington.
- Obtaining copies of Congressional and Executive Branch documents and reports dealing with topics of interest to Cyprus.
- Preparing periodic reports on the American political scene, with special emphasis on the November 1996 elections.

ATTACHMENT B

During the six-month period ending March 31, 1997, the registrant engaged in specific political activities on behalf of the Republic of Cyprus as detailed below.

Interests and policies sought to be influenced. The registrant worked to help develop congressional concern about the proposed sale by McDonnell Douglas of passenger aircraft to an airline illegally operating out of the Turkish-occupied northern area of Cyprus. This concern was expressed in individual and group letters to McDonnell Douglas, the President of the Export-Import Bank and the Secretary of State.

The registrant circulated material to Members of Congress on the decision on December 18, 1996 by the European Court of Human Rights holding Turkey responsible for violations of human rights in the northern part of Cyprus.

The registrant assisted the Embassy of Cyprus in developing a fact sheet justifying the Government of Cyprus's decision to acquire air defense missiles for the defense of its territory. The Embassy circulated the fact sheet to Members of Congress and others.

The registrant arranged meetings with Members of Congress for two visiting Members of the Cypriot Parliament. These meetings provided an opportunity for the parliamentarians to exchange views with Members of Congress on matters of interest and concern to Cyprus.

The registrant worked with Embassy of Cyprus to encourage Members of Congress to urge the Clinton Administration to launch an initiative to resolve the Cyprus problem. The registrant helped to prepare draft language for the report accompanying the fiscal year 1997 State Department authorization bill urging a US initiative to resolve the Cyprus problem.

The registrant prepared draft language for the report accompanying the fiscal year 1997 State Department authorization bill supporting the continued appropriation of \$15 million for bi-communal projects in Cyprus.

The registrant also contacted Administration officials to obtain unclassified information relating to the McDonnell Douglas aircraft sale, the annual narcotics report and trade complaints against Cyprus. The registrant also contacted Members of Congress and others before and after the November 5 US elections, for use in preparing reports to the Embassy of Cyprus on election developments and their possible implications for Cyprus.

The registrant contacted, in personal meetings or by telephone, Members of Congress and their personal staffs, or staff members of various House and Senate committees as indicated below, on one or more occasions each.
