The Government of Bolivia

The registrant continues to represent the Government of Bolivia before Congress and before various Executive Branch departments and agencies. The law firm has advised the Government of Bolivia on various issues relating to U.S.-Bolivian relations. The law firm has also provided legal advice to the Government of Bolivia on a variety of matters and continued in its representation of the Bolivian Air Force in connection with efforts by Transaero to execute a default judgment against the Air Force.

Representatives of the law firm have met with members of Congress and congressional staffers to provide information about the background to the Transaero litigation, to provide a status report on the litigation and to explain the Bolivian position. Representatives of the law firm have also assisted the Ambassador in responding to written inquiries about this litigation from members of the Senate and the House.

Gregory Mevs

During this reporting period, the registrant represented Mr. Mevs and the members of the Mevs family before various Executive Branch departments and agencies and before various Senators and representatives of the United States Congress. The registrant also advised Mr. Mevs and the Mevs family about developments affecting U.S.-Haiti relations and about ways that they could assist in the return to democracy and the strengthening of democratic institutions.
