

Taiwan Research Institute -- Cassidy & Associates has assisted the Taiwan Research Institute in advancing the appreciation of the ROC's influence on Taiwan's history, culture and democratic development through contact with public officials.

On behalf of Taiwan Research Institute, Cassidy & Associates, Inc. has worked to promote understanding and awareness of the progress made by the democracy movement in Taiwan. In meetings with U.S. Executive Branch and Legislative Branch Officials, Cassidy & Associates personnel have expressed the message that the ROC's progress in embracing democratic principles warrants greater support from the U.S. government, including high level contacts between relevant government officials on both sides of the bilateral relationship.
