SERVICE CONTRACT

(BOLAND & MADIGAN, INC.
(KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA

KNOW ALL PERSONS BY THESE PRESENTS, that BOLAND & MADIGAN, INC., a CASSIDY COMPANY, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, and doing business as CASSIDY & ASSOCIATES, INC. with its principal place of business at 700 13th Street, N.W., Suite 400, Washington, D.C. 20005, does contract with the KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA, to provide consultant services for the period of one (1) year, commencing on or about June 1, 1995, and terminating on May 31, 1996, in consideration for the payment of Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (US \$75,000) per quarter, plus expenses.

Payment shall be made to BOLAND & MADIGAN, INC. in four (4) advance quarterly payments, commencing on or before June 1, 1995, to be followed by a payment on or before the first day of each of the next three (3) quarters with the final payment due on or before March 31, 1996.

A statement of expenses shall be made to the KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA by BOLAND & MADIGAN, INC. at the end of each quarter for expenses incurred during the previous quarter. The statement shall be made payable quarterly.

In its capacity, BOLAND & MADIGAN, INC. shall make its best effort to assist the KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA in advancing its appreciation of Saudi Arabia's history, cultural uniqueness and economic development. The nature of these objectives shall be further developed by the KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA with the advice and assistance of BOLAND & MADIGAN, INC.

BOLAND & MADIGAN, INC. with the cooperation of the KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA, will conduct an extensive inventory of interests; develop the concept for agreed-upon initiatives; create a theme for these initiatives; and formulate a comprehensive plan and timetable for the initiatives.

At the end of each year of services under this contract, this contract shall be extended for an additional one (1) year term unless the KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA notifies BOLAND & MADIGAN, INC. of its decision to terminate this agreement in writing by registered mail delivered at least ninety (90) days before the scheduled renewal.
