

Privacy Act Statement. 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Dear Senator Dole:

I am delighted that we will have the opportunity to work together on behalf of The Embassy of Cyprus. We have agreed that for your role as an advisor to Piper Rudnick, we will compensate Alston & Bird \$12,500 monthly, effective May 1, 2003, through the pendency of Piper's current contract with Cyprus (11/30/2003), with the possibility of subsequent renewal, as mutually agreed upon. As you understand, it is also a possibility that Cyprus will determine either to diminish or cancel its contract with Piper. Should that happen, we will be forced to adjust our relationship with you accordingly.

You have agreed that in your advisory capacity, you will meet from time to time with Ambassador Marcoullis, as well as senior level Cypriot officials who may visit the U.S. Further, as we discussed, there may be, from time to time, the need for you to provide assistance in seeking meetings with senior officials of the Administration and key Republican leaders in Congress.

It was terrific seeing you yesterday. I look forward to many more.
