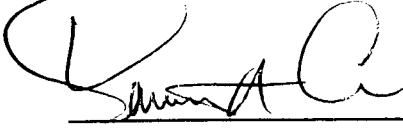

Pursuant to an agreement with The Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia Embassy, DNX Partners, LLC has provided services to the Embassy with respect to the Embassy's relationship with the U.S. Congress and the U.S. public. This included providing comments and advice to the Ambassador and some members of his staff as well as to Public Relations consultants and Government Relations consultants employed by the Embassy regarding the content of public speeches given by the Ambassador and the content of some Congressional communications. DNX Partners, LLC also advised the Embassy on strategies for dealing with Congress and U.S. government officials, and strategies for improving U.S.-Saudi bilateral relations. As anticipated in its original filings, Registrant did not engage directly in public relations or public information activities but did provide advice and counsel to the Ambassador and his staff and the Embassy existing Public Relations and Government Relations contractors on these matters.
