Good afternoon,

On behalf of the Embassy of Saudi Arabia, I wanted to bring your attention to the recent meeting on Ukraine in Jeddah hosted by the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. Please see a brief synopsis below and a statement by the Saudi Ministry of Foreign Affairs attached.

On August 5, the Kingdom hosted a meeting for National Security Advisors of various countries in Jeddah to advance principles for ending the conflict in Ukraine. Delegates from 40 countries met in the Kingdom, including from the U.S., China, India, Brazil, and South Africa. The meeting in Jeddah enabled Ukraine's leadership to directly address certain countries about its perspective on the necessary conditions for a durable peace.

The meeting is a testament to Saudi Arabia's prominent role at mediating international conflicts, showcasing the Kingdom's central role in global diplomacy. The meeting garnered praise from the U.S. government and other western nations for its contributions to building a broader consensus around the need for a just, comprehensive, and lasting peace.
