In a joint statement, the European Central Bank, the Bank of Japan, the Bank of England, the Bank of Canada and Swiss National Bank pledged they would "continue to work closely together and will take appropriate steps to address the ongoing pressures."

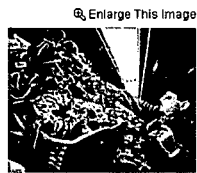

It is the first time the Food and Drug Administration has allowed any produce to be irradiated at levels needed to protect against illness.

"This is probably one of the single most safety actions done for fresh produce in Robert Brackett, chief scientist for the Manufacturers Association, which petitioned in 2000 to allow manufacturers to irradiate processed meats, fruits and vegetables.

Advocates for food safety condemned the move and asserted that irradiation could lower the quality of food and create unsafe chemicals and ruin taste.

"It's a total cop-out," said Patty Lovera of Food and Water Watch. "They don't have the authority or the political will to really protect us from unsafe food."






