ATTACHMENT

Items 11 and 12 of the registrant's Short Form, which was filed on May 14, 2019 (and amended on June 4, 2019), to register as a foreign principal, "Zaklad Metalurgiczny, through SEKCO Operating Company," should be amended to read as follows.

11. Describe separately and in detail all services which you will render to the foreign principal(s) listed in Item 10 either directly, or through the primary registrant listed in Item 8, and the date(s) of such services.

The principal in Poland has been placed in financial jeopardy by a series of judicial actions in the Polish courts. The registrant will try to help the principal resolve its legal issues in Poland by seeking the counsel of Members of Congress, officials in the Executive branch, and other interested persons who have an understanding of the contemporary situation in Poland and who may be in a position of influence there. Such services may be extended throughout the duration of the principal's contract with the primary registrant.

12. Do any of the above described services include political activity as defined in Section 1(o) of the Act and in the footnote below? Yes.

If yes, describe separately and in detail such political activity.

Members of Congress, officials in the Executive branch, and other interested persons may be contacted, so as to seek their counsel about the contemporary situation in Poland and how best the principal can go about seeking redress.
