**Government of the Republic of Trinidad & Tobago**

Regarding its representation of the foreign principal, Registrant engaged in contacts and political activities concerning matters of interest to the foreign principal during the reporting period. Registrant more broadly counseled the foreign principal on the state of affairs in the U.S., evolving public developments around the federal government, and identified strategies and engagement opportunities to enhance the bilateral relationship between the foreign principal and the U.S. Registrant generally advised the foreign principal in achieving economic diversification via potential investments and other partnership opportunities. Registrant also continued to meet with Legislative officials key to strengthening the U.S.- Trinidad and Tobago economic and security bilateral relationship. This included discussing with Members of Congress and their staffs, issues affecting the broader Caribbean region, developments in Venezuela, bilateral trade, COVID 19 global pandemic-related matters, and the foreign principal's economic diversification. Moreover, Registrant also continued to discuss with the foreign principal the U.S.'s national security interests and related matters.

**Government of Bermuda**

Registrant generally counseled the foreign principal around its economic issues, as well as its bilateral relationship with and the state of affairs within the United States. Registrant interacted with Members of Congress, their staffs, and other policymakers on the foreign principal's behalf. Specifically, Registrant engaged Congressional offices to discuss actions taking place at the Organisation of Economic Co-operation and Development. Registrant also initiated conversations around Congressional Members' interest in possibly visiting Bermuda by participating in a Mutual Education and Cultural Exchange Act (MECEA) program.

**The Government of Barbados**

Registrant counseled foreign principal on its bilateral relationship with and the state of affairs within the United States. Registrant worked to arrange meetings with Members of Congress and their staffs to engage on matters related to the foreign principal's economy, the World Bank and IMF, on COVID 19 global pandemic-related matters, bilateral trade, and on issues mutually relevant to the U.S. government and the foreign principal.
