It is a promise to work hard to achieve the goals stated therein. July 31, 2017 Foreign Principal here M. Cabrera signs letter of intent to assist in further activities of 2/11/2017 agreement. To foster increasingly better relations between The Dominican Republic and The United States of America that creates a comfortable environment for United States entities (be them individuals or otherwise) to operate in that enhances security, trade and philanthropic endeavors between the nations, with the expressed purpose of helping The Dominican Republic meet its debt obligations and enhance it's bond rating to an A-grade level.

The attachment of the promotion of the enhancement of the New York City economy through the stipulation of it's sanctuary city status and the assistance of the Foreign Principals here to make informed those with an attachment to New York that this status must be changed through such, and that a healthy New York economy is a healthy Dominican economy, to assist in this goal of enhancing the agenda described herein.

To enhance security protocols for the census of Dominicans to assist in the reduction of burdens to the United States concerning matters of immigration and/or immigration-related investigations and policies.

To develop economically areas of the Dominican Republic needy of work, education and social services.

To defeat Communism and prevent war with neighboring nations and internally as civil war with opposition factions looms.

Bearing in mind the burdens of The Dominican Republic's presumed higher than 6-in-10 dependency rate as defined by The United States, a believed 85% of private remittances to the Nation originating in New York City, NY, it is the intent of the principals and registrant to endorse New York Mayoral Candidate Bo Dietl through explaining to all Dominican-Americans of their right to vote and make public their opinion as to who they desire as Mayor. (Principals and registrant are of the opinion Candidate Dietl can effectively stipulate the Sanctuary Cities directive issued by current Mayor DiBlasio and remove planned suspension of Federal Funds to the city of New York, enhancing the economic condition of the majority of Dominicans, who rely on remittances from New York family members to survive.)

The concentrated effort to bring the Standard & Poor's Dominican Bond Rating to a sustainable A-level grade and grow the Dominican economy in a healthy, prosperous way. The means to achieve these purposes are 1) established cooperation between registrant and principals, and 2) funding as noted in the proposed budget attached hereto and further funding as raised by all legal means.
