Although Registrant is uncertain whether such analyses have actually been used in lobbying or public relations activities by or on behalf of Turkey, Registrant has reason to believe that the Embassy of Turkey in Washington, DC, occasionally has shared them with Turkey's lobbyists and public relations firms.
