

Appendix Response to Item 5

Item 5: Each item checked above must be explained below in full detail together with, where appropriate, specific reference to and identity of the item in the registration statement to which it pertains.

This filing pertains to a Government Affairs and Strategic Advisory Agreement between Von Batten-Montague-York, L.C. ("Registrant") and His Excellency Atiku Abubakar ("Client"), effective February 20, 2026.

Under the agreement, the Registrant is retained to provide lawful government affairs representation and strategic advisory services in the United States. The engagement is advisory and strategic in nature and does not constitute legal representation unless separately agreed.

As described in Sections I and II of the agreement, services may include: advising on U.S. political and national security dynamics; policy positioning and reputational strategy; preparation of briefing materials and memoranda; identification of and outreach to Members of Congress and staff; facilitation of meetings; structured engagement with executive branch departments and policy offices; development of U.S.-facing policy messaging; and coordination of institutional outreach consistent with U.S. ethics and election laws. Activities may also include preparatory strategic positioning for potential meetings between the Client and senior U.S. government officials. Any registrable contacts or political activities will be disclosed in supplemental statements as required under FARA.

The term of the agreement is twelve (12) months from the effective date, renewable by mutual written agreement (Section III).

Total compensation under the agreement is \$1,200,000 for the twelve-month term, payable in installments as outlined in Section IV. Reasonable and pre-approved expenses are reimbursable pursuant to Section V.

The agreement requires full compliance with the Foreign Agents Registration Act (22 U.S.C. § 611 et seq.), federal ethics requirements, and applicable election laws, including 52 U.S.C. § 30121 (Sections II.E and VI). The Registrant reserves the right to decline or discontinue any activity that raises legal or ethical concerns.

The agreement also includes standard confidentiality, termination, and entire-agreement provisions (Sections VII-IX).
